# End of Pacific Sports Partnerships (PSP)...



## Key Findings:

1. Significant positive impact on overall and female participation
2. Increased participation by people with a disability at community level has led to increased representation at international level
3. Increase in female staff and volunteers has bolstered confidence and additional support in the development, delivery and monitoring of programs
4. Developing capacity among local stakeholders has fostered ownership and led to improved organisational governance and capability of sport organisations
5. Strategic collaboration across sports has encouraged efficiencies in program delivery and facilitated strengthening of sport for development outcomes
6. Balancing sport for development outcomes with the need to grow and develop the sport has increased prospects of sustainability

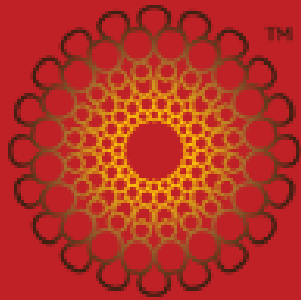




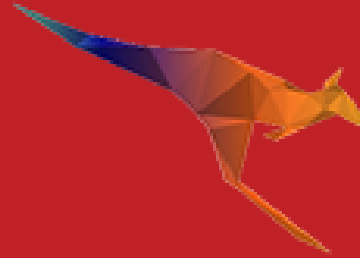
- The conference will take place in Auckland, New Zealand from 5-8 May, 2022
